

UUCC2010 CHAPERONE APPLICATION

The UUCC music camp will be held on the campus of Macalester College, St. Paul, MN. We will need about 15 adults to serve as **chaperones**. They will receive full room and board but will be responsible for their own travel expenses. All chaperones must attend an orientation meeting on Wednesday morning (June 23) and submit to a background check. Check out is by noon Monday, June 27. Chaperones will be assigned approximately 5 children to be responsible for at all times, living in the dormitory close to them, comprising a “family” unit. Chaperones should not expect to have their own child in their “camp family”. Chaperones should not expect to attend any GA events except when the children’s choir is present to rehearse or sing. Chaperones will be expected to attend all activities, meals and field trips with the children.
